- Sharon gave a presentation of the events and training taking place with Community Groups registered with Mayo PPN
- Mayo PPN held 4 Municipal District Meetings in 2019
- Elections to Co Council Committees have taken place, 25 PPN reps were elected onto various County Council committees
- The draft PPN Workplan and draft Budget for 2020 was presented to the Plenary members present. (copies were made available to members in attendance)
- Mayo PPN delivered a suite of Free Training to Community Groups registered with the PPN, over 60 groups participated in the training.
- PPN's nationally conducted a survey to Community Groups in relation to Insurance Costs. It received huge media press at local and national level
- Mayo PPN completed the re-registration of all community groups. All groups details registered with the Mayo PPN are now up to date. Mayo PPN were the first in the country to complete this re-registration process.



- Ratification for the workplan and budget were sought for 2020, which were both passed
- The results of the LCDC and JPC elections which took place prior to the meeting were announced
- Ratification of the new Mayo PPN representatives all of whom were present were ratified.
